SHOW JUROR AND JUDGE: Ann Templeton

ELIGIBILITY

Open to all pastelists currently residing within the US borders. Artwork must be at least 80% soft pastel. Nupastels and similar “harder” pastels are considered soft pastels. Oil pastels are not considered pastels.

Artwork must be original, not more than 3 years old, not done in a class or under supervision of another artist, and not copied from published photos or from photos taken by others without their permission. If copyright infringement is discovered the artwork will be disqualified. Tastefully done nudes will be accepted at the discretion of the exhibition committee.

Artwork must be wired and ready for hanging. No clip frames, sawtooth hangers, or string hangers permitted. If mats are used, they must be white or off-white. Paintings with colored mats can be accepted to the show, but will not be considered for awards. **Framed size should not exceed 48" high by 36" wide.**

All paintings entered in this Juried Competition MUST BE FOR SALE.

ENTRY DETAILS

Three entries allowed per artist by CD only. Entry fee of \$25 for 1 to 3 entries for current APS members and \$35 for 1-3 entries for non-members. APS dues of \$25.00 for the 2010-2011 program year are due September 1st, 2010 and should be paid by the time of entry in this show.

Checks should be made payable to APS. Non-members may join at the time of entry. APS membership is \$25 and is from September to September. No more than two paintings may be juried into the show from any one artist.

CD Entry Only. Submit up to three digital images on one CD.

- Only jpg files accepted.
- Image size must be 800 pixels on the longest side and image quality 300 dpi.
- Name the jpg file as follows: *painting name.jpg*
- Label the CD in permanent ink with your full name and the names of the paintings.

The Haywood County Arts Council provides insurance for paintings at the show. However, those wishing more insurance coverage are responsible for obtaining it.

The Sales Commission is 35%. All paintings must be for sale. Prices listed on the entry form are binding.

HOW & WHERE TO SHIP YOUR ARTWORK:

Shipped Artwork MUST be shipped via UPS or FED-Ex to the Gallery 86, Haywood County Arts Council, 86 North Main Street, Waynesville, NC 28786.

All shipped entries must be sturdily framed using plexi-glass. No glass will be accepted for shipped artwork. Must include RETURN PREPAID LABEL, including pre-payment for UPS / FedEx pickup charges, with shipped painting, or artwork will not be returned. The artist is responsible for insurance during shipping. Damage in transit is the responsibility of the artist.

Receipt of work: The Gallery will accept work delivered between September 29 and October 8, 2010, during gallery hours only (10am-5pm, M-F). Please be sure the shipper is aware of the delivery hours. (See show location above). Any received after this date will not be accepted. Artwork will be delivered by UPS/ FedEx and stored at the Gallery until hanging. Shipping materials will be stored during the show and used for return shipment.

Hand delivered artwork will be accepted on Friday October 8th and Monday, October 11th, from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm both days. If you are unable to bring your paintings these days, please make arrangements to have them delivered.

If an artist fails to get ALL of his accepted work to the gallery for the show, he will forfeit his right to enter and show in an APS exhibit for 2 years. Any Artwork unclaimed 30 days after the date of exhibition closing will become property of APS.

SUBMISSION CHECK LIST for Appalachian Pastel Society 2010 National Exhibition:

1. Check for \$25 for members made payable to APS. Add \$25 for membership renewal fee due September. (New members should also submit membership form available on APS website) or \$35 for non-members .
2. CD labeled with your full name and titles of your paintings. CD should contain up to 3 images in jpg format, size 800 pixels on the longest side, 300 dpi. Image file name should be *paintingtitle.jpg*. Need help with this? See the APS website for Instruction Link; appalachian-pastel-society.org.
3. Entry Form: Complete and include both lower sections. Read and sign “Agreement Statement” below.
4. Self-addressed, stamped #10 envelope for juror notification and critiques from juror.
5. Keep a copy of this form for your records.
